



Pak N Save—Moorhouse Ave Chch

System: RoofLogic Overlay, HD lightweight roof board and FiberTite, 7000m²

The insulated panel roof on PAK N SAVE Moorhouse Ave had severe leaking issues and the most common option to remove and replace with new seemed like an impossible task for a store that was open 18 hours a day and the Health and safety issues for shoppers and impact on the store.

SWP commercial were approached by Foodstuffs to come up with a re-roof solution. This re-roof solution not only had to have zero impact on the stores day to day running, it also needed to be a lightweight solution due to snow loads in Chch.

The solution was a mix of rigid insulation, high-density ISO board and FiberTite. Because of the time frame, 1000m² had to be installed every week, this was easily met with a committed SWP team and the help of a dry Christchurch in March and April.

Since this project SWP have been involved with Foodstuffs in further roofing solutions on new and existing buildings.
