Works in progress :

- Replacement of corbels and dental elements
- Running of new cornices in situ
- Crack repairs and reinforcement of the substrate
- Waterproofing of all parapets ledges
- Re-plastering and Re-coating of the entire facade

Complete Refurbishment

The building has being completely refurbished both externally and internally including installation of seismic foundation.

The brick construction has suffered over many years from significant water penetration, damaging the entire fabric of the building.

Sto products were selected in respect of their unique properties having a micro-porous structure which allows the transmission of water vapour. StoArmat RFP meshed reinforcement plaster is being used as part of the repair process providing a means to strengthen and reinforce the facade of the building.
